We are pleased to announce the first annual Cavallino Classic Competition for the vintage and classic racing Ferraris and Maseratis.

This set of races will encourage owners of the older competition cars to bring them out and race them, just as in days gone by when these race cars were in their prime and were inspiring crowds everywhere.

These race cars are split into two groups – drum brake, which covers cars from approximately 1947 to 1960, and disc brake, which covers 1961 to 1980. This gives all the cars, in each race, a better than equal chance at success. Within each group are several more classes, based on the type

and age of each car and each one has a chance for a class win.

Ferraris and Maseratis that were designed and made as competition cars in these years are eligible. Many are significant racing cars, with great provenance. You are seeing history being re-enacted, and history being made once again.

The racing is fully competitive. Drivers must be the owners, and they must have a competition license.

We wish to thank all the owners who have brought their rare race cars to the Cavallino Classic to compete, an experience for all racing enthusiasts to enjoy.
